- The competition is time bound and you can submit your entries in respective competitions from 25th September to 2nd October
- Discourage the creation of multiple accounts each individual may only use a single account to enter the contest.
- It is mandatory to mention our handle/hashtag in your update so we can see all the entries.
- Encourage the use of topics relevant to the contest (NEP)
- Adhere to applicable laws and regulations of Social Media with regard to prohibited content and trademarked content

Standard Rules and Regulations



- Follow Content Boundaries Intellectual Property (no plagiarism)
- Contestants to use given hashtag only for the purpose of competition and not else-wise.
- You are free to use English/Hindi or any other regional language while participating in any of the competitions
- References for the content can be taken from the text module on NEP given at our website
- A participant can participate in one or more competitions at the same time with single registration
- Standard rules of each competition will be available on website.
