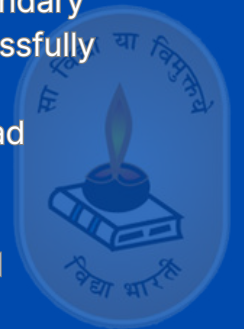

Akhil Bharatiya Workshop for Primary, Pre-Secondary and Higher Secondary

Establish Student Counseling Centers in Schools

Jabalpur (MP) | Vidya Bharati's Akhil Bharatiya Workshop for Primary, Pre-Secondary and Higher Secondary Groups was held in Jabalpur from Aug 30 to Sep 1.

In the 13 educational sessions conducted during the workshop, in-depth discussions were held on the implementation of the NEP, 21st-century skills, five-step lesson plan, holistic development, child and adolescent psychology, personality development, Vidya Bharati's objectives, classroom management, teacher's diary, teaching aids, activity- and experiment-based learning, portfolio preparation, evaluation methods, and notebook inspection.

At the conclusion of the workshop, an action plan for the upcoming academic session was formulated, with a collective resolve to make education in Vidya Bharati schools more creative, practical, and value-oriented. Shri Shriram Aaravkar, Joint Organizing Secretary, spoke on the formation, functions, importance, and current status of educational councils. It was decided that information regarding regional workshops would be sent to the central office, one member of the Akhil Bharatiya team would be included, subject experts would be invited, educational materials shared, and mobile phone usage kept limited.



Vidya Bharati's Akhil Bharatiya General Secretary, Shri Deshraj Sharma, highlighted "School Structure" in line with the NEP and skill development for the 21st century. He explained that child psychology is essential for studying thoughts, emotions, behavior, and learning processes. Identifying and resolving challenges also come under child psychology, which covers the age span from birth to 17 years. Psychology plays a crucial role in creating an educational environment. The personality of a child can be developed according to interests, culture, and tendencies. In childhood, children imitate elders; therefore, they should be provided with role models. A positive environment should be created, and Student Counseling Centers must be set up in schools to assess and support children. Students should also be encouraged to communicate with animals and plants.

The workshop was guided by prominent leaders, including Shri Shiv Prashad (Akhil





Bharatiya Secretary), Shri Devkinandan Chaurasia (Akhil Bharatiya Training Team Member), Shri Amit Dave (Prant Organizing Secretary, Mahakaushal), and Shri Surendra Kumar Jain (Akhil Bharatiya Coordinator, Upper Primary Education). Shri Rajeev Gupta led discussions for the Secondary Group, while Shri Surendra Kumar Jain guided the Primary and Upper Primary Groups, emphasizing classroom management, group discussions, demonstration of experiments, project methods, and child-centered learning.

The role of the Educational Council is to enhance educational quality. Workshops provide vision, and based on this, one-year, two-year, and three-year plans should be made at the regional level. Deliberations should be held with full-time education

heads in each province to accelerate the pace of student learning and ensure leadership in the education sector. Educational councils must aim to enhance quality by increasing membership, encouraging coordinators and co-coordinators to contribute actively, adopting digital tools such as TARA and AL, creating a central system to disseminate materials across regions, enriching libraries, and ensuring participation of coordinators for classes 9–12 in CBSE/NCERT activities. The workshop witnessed the participation of 35 workers from nine regions of the country (excluding the West and South) and various provinces. Among them were 30 group coordinators and co-coordinators, 2 A.Bh. coordinators, 2 subject in-charges, and 1 subject presenter.

Disciples Immortalized Their Teachers — Scholarship and Lab Established in Their Names

Shri Dinanath Batra was an Bharatiya educationist and the General Secretary of Vidya Bharati, the school network run by the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). He also founded the Shiksha Bachao Andolan Samiti and the Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas.

Nominated for the Padma Shri in 2019, Shri Brij Lal was an alumnus and later a teacher at SMB Geeta Senior Secondary School, Railway Road, Kurukshetra. Over his illustrious 58-year career as a teacher and principal, countless renowned personalities had the opportunity to learn under him.

Kurukshetra | The alumni of SMB Geeta Sr Sec School have immortalized their two teachers. They established a center in the name of Mathematics teacher Shri Brij Lal, where students have been practicing for the last two years. Alongside this, plans are underway to build an English lab in the name of English teacher Shri Dinanath Batra. A scholarship in his name is also being introduced.

Though these teachers are no longer in this world, their names will remain eternal through these initiatives. Their strict discipline and values shaped students so profoundly that many alumni today hold significant positions across Bharat and abroad.

The school was founded on Kurukshetra's soil by RSS's second Sarsanghchalak Shri Madhavrao Sadashivrao Golwalkar in 1946. Shri Dinanath Batra served the school from 1964 to 1991 as both a teacher and later as principal.

Shri Brij Lal too was known for his strictness in academics, which his students now acknowledge as the key reason behind their success.
