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District Center School Visit - Hariom Sanskar Kendra, Jodhpur

Under the Akhil Bharatiya visit Program of Vidya Bharati in the Jodhpur Province, Shri Govind Mahant, Akhil Bharatiya Organizing Secretary, during his visit, observed various activities such as Vandana, physical activities, songs, poems, bhajans, games, quizzes, discussions, and meeting with the center committee at the Hariom Sanskar Kendra, located at 'Guru Ka Talab' and managed by Adarsh Vidya Mandir HSC School, Keshav Parisar, Jodhpur. After the observation, contact was made with two families in the locality. Provincial Karyakartas were also present during the visit.



District Center School Visit

The visit to Adarsh Vidya Mandir HSC School, Keshav Parisar, Jodhpur, included Vandana, physical activities, plantation, and visit of the Shishu Vatika section, observation of boys' and girls' wings, and a meeting with the principal and committee Karyakarta. During the address, Shri Govind ji emphasized the importance of working with dedication and becoming motivated Karyakarta. He mentioned that the number of Shishu Vatikas should increase, the school's furniture should be aligned with the NEP, and all Karyakarta should study NEP.



He also stressed that activity-based teaching should be adopted and that everyone should actively participate in physical activities. He encouraged motivating girls to move forward and urged the school to become a model institution.

District Team and District Center School Principal-Manager Meeting

At the provincial office of Vidya Bharati, 'Shrutam', a meeting was held with the district team and the principals and managers of district center schools. During this meeting, information was gathered about the district team, 12 well-organized Shishu Vatikas, ideal Sanskar Kendras, quality educational arrangements in 10th and 12th level schools, and a review based on the District Center SESQ Report. The principals of district center schools presented a PowerPoint presentation on the effective implementation of these plans.

In his address, Shri Govind Ji discussed in detail the support by stronger schools to weaker schools,



the maintenance of all schools in the district, the movement of the district team, the sequence of meetings, task reviews, the quality educational system of schools, and the achievements of the schools. Self-management is essential in life - Avneesh Ji



Jodhpur | A two-days selected Karyakarta workshop of Vidya Bharati Jodhpur Province was held at the provincial office 'Shrutam' on February 6-7, in the presence of Akhil Bharatiya General Secretary Shri Avneesh Bhatnagar and Provincial Secretary Shri Bhairupal Singh Ji.

Shri Avneesh Ji emphasized that Vidya Bharati's core principles include ideological foundations, Bharatiya values, Hindutva, and others. He highlighted that self-management is crucial in life. He stressed that the education given by our ancestors and sages should be implemented. There are three main objectives of education | First, transmission of ancient knowledge to the new generation; second, creating new knowledge; and third, making the future generation capable of facing challenges. He also mentioned that effective time management leads to less stress. The development of the National education system is essential, but understanding the history of Rajasthan, the tradition of devotion, and learning about great personalities through stories and folk songs is important, even if not directly examined. Ethical living and Nationalism should be based on morality. Leaders must be cautious about management, impartiality, listening to everyone, transparency, and confidentiality.



Meeting of Mahila Karyakartas

Bikaner | Mahila Karyakartas meeting of four districts was held at Adarsh Vidya Mandir, Vyas Colony, Bikaner. During this meeting, Shri Avneesh Ji explained the objectives of girls'

education, stating that motherhood inherently does not involve hostility against anyone. Because of motherhood, mothers develop virtues in their children according to the circumstances of time and place. He emphasized the need to organize programs that develop leadership qualities in girls, like those of Mata Jijabai and Rani Lakshmbai, in Vidya Mandirs. Girls in Vidya Bharati schools naturally acquire leadership qualities alongside their education. Women in the family play a vital role in family management and organizational development. Shri Avneesh Ji also mentioned the importance of setting good examples of change before the new generation and highlighted the need to guide girls on what is right and wrong. He emphasized that it is essential to address the problems faced by girls in society today. He mentioned that developing the leadership qualities of Lokmata Ahilyabai Holkar is a significant objective of girls' education.
