

Alumni Meet At The First School Of Vidya Bharati In Gorakhpur



Goraksh Pranta, organized an Almuni meet at the first school of Vidya Bharati - Saraswati Shishu Mandir, in Pakkibag, Gorakhpur on 12th January.

In 1952 some patriots, including Social Worker Nanaji Desmukh, founder of Gita Press Bhai Hanuman Prasad Poddar, Industrialist Bala Babu Tulsyan, Educationist Dr Devi Prasad Agarwal, Social Worker Krishna Chandra Gandhi, established a small Saraswati Shishu Mandir in Gorakhpur to provide value based education in tune with the Indian culture. Creating a distinct identity in the society led us to establish more such schools. The need to form a national organization was felt and in 1977 Vidya Bharati Akhil Bhartiya Siksha Sansthan was established.

Today we have 12,828 formal schools and 11,353 informal schools.

In this alumni meet Sri Shiv Kumar, National Secretary of Vidya Bharati addressed the gathering. He talked of the importance of inculcating patriotism and teaching students of our culture and history. Emphasising on the need of value education, he said that the nation needs youth who have 'sanskars' and character. It is only such youth that can take the nation forward.

Sri Shreyansh Mohan, Deputy Commissioner of Mumbai Customs, was the Chief Guest on the occasion. Other dignitaries included Sri Prashant

Deputy Commissioner, Hyderabad And Alumnus, R Shashidhara Chary, Shares His Passion For Social Service And Rural Development



Though rapid urbanization is taking place in India, with approximately 121 Crore people still residing in villages (2011 census), the soul of India is undoubtedly rural in nature. In a developing country like India, several rural areas are still lagging behind in an assortment of sectors in relation to their urban counterparts such as education, healthcare, transportation, agriculture, sanitation etc. Keeping the present scenario in mind, it is highly crucial to put continued effort towards the development of this sector.

Vidya Bharati alumnus R Shashidhara Chary of Saraswati Shishumandir school, Karimnagar, Telangana grew up in a household witnessing his father, who worked in government service engaged in the advancement of rural sector. The dedication of his father inspired Sri R Shashidhara Chary to work in the same field.

He started his career as 'Junior Assistant' in Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) after passing his Group-II B examination in 1991, where he worked for 4 years. In 1995 he got selected as 'Deputy Tahsildar' by APPSC and worked for 6 years. Later he was promoted to 'Tahsildar' in 2000. He held the post till 2007 and worked in remote and Naxal infested areas of Karimnagar district. In 2007 he became 'Commercial Tax Officer' and presently is working as Deputy Commissioner in Hyderabad City.

During his long tenure, as 'Deputy Tehsildar', he was associated with numerous rural developmental activities in the fields of housing, sanitation, health and family planning. In between the time frame of 2000-2002, he along with his team had conducted many 'Family Planning Camps' in their area which was immensely successful. Nearly 1000 Family Planning operations took place due to his effort.

Along with his developmental work through his profession Sri R Shashidhara Chary is also an advisor to <u>We Shall Overcome</u> trust since 2017 which is involved with varied social work, in the fields of health, environment, education and child development. He took an active part towards mobilization of more than 20 lakh rupees as corpus fund of the organization.

While talking about the impact of his school, Sri R Shashidhara Chary stressed on the fact that the lessons of 'Dharma', 'Seva' and Sacrifice taught to him in his school still acts as a guiding force in his life. He is still in touch with his 'acharyas' who have taught him and likes to spend quality time in their presence whenever he visits his hometown. He hopes that in future, Vidya Bharati will be able to establish more English medium schools in the rural areas, so that more children can get the benefit of complete education as given by Vidya Bharati schools.

According to Sri R Shashidhara Chary, his entire family, starting from his parents, Sri Niranjana Chary and mother Smt. Kshema, his wife Pavithra and himself has always been passionate about serving society and wishes that in the near future, his son, Anurag can also prove to be an ideal citizen and an avid social worker.

When asked about the impact that his school has had on his life, Dr. Menaria said that apart from introducing him to Yoga, the important life lessons learned from his school was the concept of time management and necessity of discipline in daily life. He also credits his school for acquainting him with the stories of great men like Swami Vivekananda, Maharishi Arvind and Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, from whom he draws his inspiration.

It is really heartening to see Vidya Bharati alumni like Dr. Vikram Menaria engaged towards strengthening the rich legacy of Indian culture.
