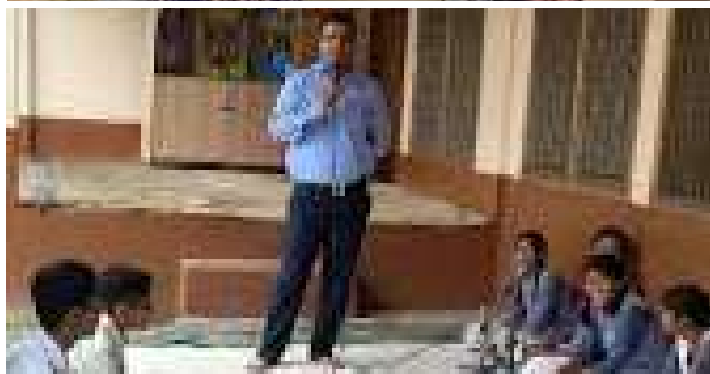
Guru Purnima Celebration in Vidya Bharati Schools
