Palak Malik won Bronze Medal in Wrestling Competition held in Russia

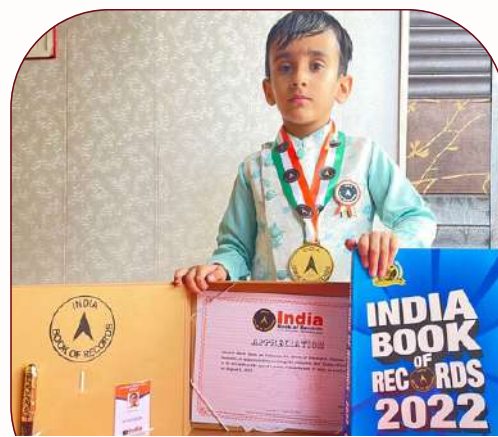
