


Pious Remembrance: The Great Educationist Dinanath Batra Ji



Dinanath Batra Ji, the National Convener of Shiksha Bachao Andolan and a distinguished educationist, passed away on November 7, 2024, at the age of 94. He was born on March 5, 1930, in the Rajanpur, district Dera Ghazi Khan (then part of undivided Bharat, now in Pakistan). Through his dedication, service, and unwavering commitment to education, he ushered a new direction to the Bharatiya education system. His contributions were exemplary and inspirational, not only to the Vidya Bharati organization but to the entire nation. He was Akhil Bharatiya General Secretary of Vidya Bharati from 1988 to 2004. The First Historic Principal Conference

Under the leadership of Dinanath Batra Ji, the first Akhil Bharatiya Principal Conference was held at Geeta Vidyalaya. This conference brought the principals and educationists from across the country together on a single platform, offering a new direction and perspective for education. Significant Contribution to Vidya Bharati

From 1988 to 2004, Dinanath Batra Ji served as the Akhil Bharatiya General Secretary of Vidya Bharati. These books have provided a new direction and perspective in the field of education.

Dinanath Batra Ji also launched an intellectual struggle on various controversial issues related to education. He believed that education is not merely a medium of acquiring knowledge but plays a vital role in nation-building. Emphasis on Value-Based School Environment




Honors and Awards, including National Award

Harsh Ji's Early Life and Contribution

Harsh Ji was born on November 27, 1961, in Nangal Raya, Delhi. His family had migrated from present-day Pakistan and settled in Sonipat, Haryana, before moving to Delhi. His father, Shri Virendra Kumar Arya, was a Swayamsevak of with the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) and an activist of the ideological organization Akhil Bharatiya Shikshak Mahasangh. Harsh Ji's grandfather was a freedom fighter. From a young age, Harsh Ji was inspired by his family's legacy to contribute to the nation, society, religion, and Bharat Mata. A local Shakha was near their home, and he began attending the RSS Shakha. Over time, he held various responsibilities, as the Gana Shikshak, Vistarak, Mukhya Shiksha and Pracharak.

Life as a Pracharak

Harsh Ji completed his mechanical engineering studies at ITI, Delhi, and later interned in Hyderabad. However, after the 1984 anti-Sikh riots, he decided that his services were needed in Punjab. He moved to Ludhiana for his internship and simultaneously worked with the RSS there. Harsh Ji began his life as a Pracharak in Charakhi Dadri, Haryana. He also worked as a Pracharak in Kala Amb and Narayangarh in Haryana. After some time, for personal reasons, he had to step back from his role as a full-time Pracharak. He then worked as a teacher at MCL SBM, Hari Nagar, Delhi.

Later, during the period of terrorism in Jammu & Kashmir in the 1990s, Harsh Ji resumed his work as a Pracharak in Rajouri and Poonch in Jammu. Subsequently, he worked as the Prant Sangathan Mantri for Vidya Bharati in Jammu & Kashmir, Haryana, and Assam.

Harsh Ji's Contribution to Vidya Bharati and His Dedication to Service

From 2010 to 2024, Harsh Ji served as the Prashikshan evam Seva Kshetra ke Shikhsa Pramukh for Vidya Bharati's North Zone. His center was located at Vidyadham, Jalandhar.

A Skilled and Knowledgeable Trainer

Harsh Ji possessed multifaceted personality and was well-versed in various fields, including medicine. He always sought to learn something new. He had a good understanding of computers and software tools. He would often use clips from documentaries and films in his training sessions, showcasing his creative approach. He was known as a well-organized and effective trainer. His ability to explain complex subjects and methodologies in simple yet deep terms left a lasting impression on Vidya Bharati. Additionally, Harsh Ji was adept at solving the problems of others.

Overcoming Challenges

As a child, Harsh Ji struggled with stuttering, which often made his speech unclear. His mother, in a caring tone, would mention how he stammered and could not speak clearly. To this, Harsh Ji would confidently reply, "Mother, one day you will be proud of me." Years later, during his final rites, when she saw the gathering of volunteers and noticed their moist eyes, she remembered his words and felt a sense of contentment and pride.

Service to the Motherland

Harsh Ji dedicated his entire life wholeheartedly to serve the nation. He had made a pledge to donate his body to the "Dadhichi Dehdan Samiti," Which his family honoured after his passing away.

Seva Prakalp (Service Project) Yashwant Bal Sanskar Kendra-A Story of Community and Support

Kilbil Academy, Raver (Shishu Vatika), Devgiri Prant

Kilbil Academy, part of Vidya Bharati Devgiri Prant's Educational Institutions, has been operating for 14 years in Raver city. Seven years ago, Yashwant Bal Sanskar Kendra was established to support children who were unable to attend school for various reasons.

Initially, these children were afraid of and hesitant to leave their homes. Even if they did step outside, they would not stay for long. It was then decided to create a safe and welcoming space for them, right where they felt comfortable. This led to the idea of setting up a Rangoli (traditional decorative art) corner in open spaces in the slums. Children started coming regularly to sit and create beautiful designs, and soon, their play attracted other children to join in. In an effort to support these children further, Yashwant Pratishthan, Raver started a Clothing Bank, where the parents of Kilbil School contributed their children's old clothes, toys, and other materials. These items were then distributed to the children in need. Subsequently, the "Póli Bhaji" (Bread and Vegetable) center was launched, providing meals to the children, thanks to contributions from the community. Many individuals stepped forward to assist in this initiative, enabling the children to focus on their studies.

The challenges increased during the COVID-19 pandemic, but the efforts continued, and the project evolved from just being a community effort to a united family-like environment. The children now celebrate festivals like Dahi Handi, Dussehra, Diwali, Gudhi Padwa, and others as a family, finding joy and fulfillment in these moments. This service project has been supported by various people, including mine owners Shri Rajendra Chaudhary and Shrimati Rekhatai Chaudhary, the Vidya Bharati family, and Shri Sushil Bhau Wani, among others. Their collective support has made this endeavor a success, helping to bring education, love, and care to children in need.
