Vidya Bharati's National Master Trainers Workshop Concludes in Bhopal; 75 Trained Master Trainers to Promote a Culture of Skill Education Across Schools



Bhopal: In line with the NEP'20 and the National Curriculum Framework (NCF) 2023, and under the guidance of NCERT, the three-day "Kaushal Bodh (Vocational Education) Master Trainers Training Workshop" organized by Vidya Bharati Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan concluded on Thursday at the Pandit Sundarlal Sharma Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE), Bhopal.

The valedictory session was attended by Shri Gobind Mahant, Organising Secretary of Vidya Bharati Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan; Shriram Aravkar, Joint Organising Secretary; Deshraj Sharma, General Secretary; and Prof. Pankaj Mehta, Training Coordinator at PSSCIVE.

Representatives selected from 11 regions across the country participated in the workshop, resulting in the preparation of approximately 75 national-level Master Trainers. These trained educators will organize state-level training workshops in their respective regions and extend Skill Awareness (Kaushal Bodh) activities to schools, thereby fostering a culture of skill development among students.

Addressing the valedictory session, Shri Deshraj Sharma, General Secretary of Vidya Bharati Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan, said that the NEP'20 has brought about a transformational change in the education system, and skill development forms the foundation of this transformation.

He remarked that skill education had long been a missing component of mainstream education, and the new policy is effectively addressing this gap.

During the three-day training programme, participants not only gained theoretical knowledge but also acquired practical experience through hands-on activities. They interacted and worked alongside skilled professionals such as carpenters, cooks, electricians, and gardeners, experiencing the concept of "Learning by Doing" in a real-world setting.



The workshop included practical sessions on 3D printing, block printing, cooking, kitchen gardening, group activities in skill laboratories, presentations, and various life-oriented vocational tasks, enabling participants to understand the process of experiential skill learning. Participants realized that genuine skills are developed not merely through textbooks but through practical work, continuous practice, and hands-on experience.

Experts also delivered sessions on vocational domains related to Life Forms, Machines & Materials, and Human Services. Participants received training in activity-based learning, project-based education, entrepreneurship, collaboration with local industries and businesses, and skill-based assessment, equipping them to effectively implement vocational education in schools in accordance with the vision of NEP 2020.



The Entire Training Was Based on the Panchapadi Learning Process

Bhopal: The workshop presented the Indian concept of Kaushal Bodh (Skill Awareness) through the Panchapadi Learning Process, comprising five stages—Adhiti (Learning), Bodh (Understanding), Abhyas (Practice), Prayog (Application), and Prasar (Dissemination). The primary objective of the training was to cultivate respect for work, self-reliance, and life-oriented skills among students.

The Master Trainers prepared through this national workshop will, in the coming months, conduct training programmes in their respective regions and states. Subsequently, skill-based activities will be introduced at the school level, enabling students to actively engage in experiential learning and helping establish a culture of skill development in educational institutions.

This initiative will accelerate the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and make a significant contribution towards the vision of building an Atmanirbhar Bharat.
