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Conceptual Article Realization of 'self' in life and creation of society based on 'self'

The basic basis of survival in society is 'self'. If there is no self, then even society cannot exist. For example, the country of Persia is in front of us, there is nothing of Persia in Persia, neither language, nor worship, nor great men, nor texts. They have nothing of their own. Society died due to the disappearance of 'self'. Some Persians are there in Bharat, Tata, etc. and not the one with Greece, Greek Gods and Goddesses, temples, statues. Aristotle. Archimedes. Socrates, Megasthenes, Pythagoras today. If there is no 'self' then the society slowly lags and dies. Bharat survived the attacks of Huns, Yavanas etc. but the attacks of Islam shook us.

Islam tried to destroy our religion and philosophy. Then came the British, French, Portuguese, Dutch, Christians, etc. The French in Pondicherry, the Portuguese in Goa, and the English Christians in the rest of Bharat wanted to destroy us. The long struggle and subjugation for 900 years shook the Hindu society, and many things were destroyed. The situation became such that the body remained, breathing remained, that's it.

Accept what is good, that is, do not be fanatic. But preserving one's 'self' is equally important. External invaders attacked this 'self' of ours. Keeping in mind that many foreign elements entered us. Removed something unnecessary from our language. The first attack was on language. After 1950, many words like telephone – hello were established in our language. Gradually in life, many unnecessary words of English have started entering the language because there is no sense of 'self'.

Shri Sudarshan ji always insisted on signing in Hindi. One should write and speak on a blackboard instead of a blackboard. You can try to remove words from foreign languages while using your indigenous language carefully. We can discuss how this experiment should be done properly.

Food is God's offering. It has mental importance. It's not just food. (Arabic word for food, treasure), cooking food only for oneself is called a sin. Cooking and feeding others are a virtue. भुञ्जते ते त्वघं पापा ये पचन्त्यात्मकारणात् ।।



Shrimad Bhagavad Geeta 3.13. Do you do food mantra while eating at home? Are indigenous food items decreasing? Are bakery items like pizza etc. not increasing? Food is a form of Prasad; food should be accepted as Prasad with purity and sanctity. Not stale. Many types of delicious dishes can be prepared.

Similarly, during puja on auspicious occasion, one should wear suitable clothes and not one's own clothes; on the occasions of Ekadashi fast, Kartik Purnima, Holi, Diwali etc. one should wear clothes as per one's culture.

According to Hindu art, Hindu architecture, Ramakrishna Mission. Bharatiya Vidva Bhavan, Swami Pranavananda, Ramdev Baba, Gayatri Parivar, Ram Mandir have been built or are being built in accordance with Bharati architecture. The plans of their houses are being built according to the western model (i.e., no courtyard). A house without a courtyard is their compulsion because it is colder in the Northern Hemisphere, but we live near the Tropic of Cancer, where it is hotter, hence, due to more heat, the courtyard has importance in our Vaastu.

Bharatiya time calculation: The new generation does not know the names of its 12 months and does not know the direction. The birth date of Students should be celebrated on Bharatiya date. We should insist on keeping both the dates on the identity card.

The library, puja room, place for taking off shoes, picture decoration etc. should be as per the tradition. Rangoli, lamp, Tulsi should be visible at the door as soon as you enter. Our feelings towards the sky, the earth, ... **Cont.**

the sun, the moon, the animals should be expressed through the conduct of 'self', the essence of behaviour towards the worldly world has been described in our old stories. Hindu's 'self' is mixed with nature, that is why water is called water god, air is called wind god, etc. The one who gives is God, the sun has given light, the earth has given crops, etc. These gods are between God and us. Hindutva is the unity of man with nature.

Our insistence on truth remains constant. Foreign travellers have written, Bharatiya do not lie. Devotion to truth was said to be the specialty of Bharat. Non-violence - therefore should be no violence of any kind, i.e., there should be no violence of speech or mind, this has been our insistence. Frugal life is our 'self'. This culture of thrift is imparted to Students. How to explain the situation of Aparigraha to Students. Excessive accumulation, collection and consumption is not good. This is the root of corruption. There should be less tendency to accumulate, this is the mother of corruption. Waking up in the morning, doing puja, remembering God etc. have been the initial part of our daily routine. Taking something out of what you must serve others is 'self'. Take two from what you have earned, this is Bharatiya culture. When wheat is harvested in the fields, distribution of shares to different sections of the society is done. It should be brought to your home later. Women sowing seeds while ploughing sing songs – O Lord, give me a good harvest! She sings while planting paddy – Sadhu, Sanyasi, guest, I will give it to everyone only then I will keep it.

Spiritual sense – To explain to Students that we are all one, not two. Bird, bird, cow, buffalo, horse, all are the same. Duality is visible, inside there is non-duality. It is fundamental that the sense of oneness develops. Expansion of unity outside: Mountains, rivers, cities, great men, lyricists, artists, scientists all belong to us.

One experiences this greater 'self' only when this sense of unity becomes deeply ingrained. Based on this 'self' the spirit of the country should be established. Unity-Advaita became the language of Bharatiya philosophy.

Educational Experiment

New experiments in Music Subject

New experiments done in the subject of music in Saraswati Bal Mandir, Rajouri Garden, Delhi affiliated by Vidya Bharati and their impact on the students.



Music is one of the important subjects among the five basic subjects in the schools run by Vidva Bharati Akhil Bharativa Shiksha Sansthan which is compulsory for every student in every school. Vidya Bharati is committed to the all-round development of students. Therefore, music plays an important role in this direction. Vidya Bharati has prepared a syllabus for singing and playing music class. Through the activities required in the Vandana session of the school, there is awakening of devotion, faith, love, goodwill, patriotism etc. in the students along with personality development.

Some new experiments were conducted about music among the students of Saraswati Bal Mandir, Rajouri Garden School of Vidya Bharati Delhi Prant, the effect of which was as follows -

1) Syllabus: - The course is divided into two parts. One part is related to the Vandana session, and the other part follows the classical and experimental nature of music. In Rajouri Garden School, the students of a class are distributed in three groups during the music period, that is, the student chooses one among singing, playing, and dancing as per his interest and learns that genre throughout the year for which three rooms and three music teachers have been appointed in the school.

The complete curriculum of music has been distributed keeping in mind the holidays and periods in the 12 months of the year.

The book Sa Re Ga Ma Pa Dha Ni is mandatory for students. In which general information about classical and experimental aspects of music is available. By preparing the students according to this curriculum, their ability to know and understand music has developed. About 60-70% students take full advantage of it. Every year there is an opportunity to learn three Akhil Bharatiya songs as well as songs from the five Prants falling in the Poorvottar Kshetra. Due to which the students also get the opportunity to get acquainted with the Prantiya languages around them and their musical styles. Students have more desire to learn songs in these languages. There're about 60 musical instruments in the music room for playing, due to which students get enthusiastic about learning musical instruments. Similarly, in the dance hall, 20-20 pairs of 25 ghungroo strings for the infant category, 50 ghungroo strings for the child category and 20-20 pairs of 100 ghungroo strings for the teenage category have been included. Along with this, props material for folk dance has also been arranged so that the students can get full benefit. This experiment conducted by the Music Department has not only given the students an opportunity to learn art as per their interest but has also increased their skills, courage, and self-respect.

In the Vandana session, Ekatmta Mantra, Ekatmta Stotra, morning remembrance, Shri Hanuman Chalisa recitation, Manas Prasang, Ashtadashshloki Gita, Panchang, thoughts, motivational stories, national anthem, national song etc. developed devotion among the students and developed the basic stream of Bharatiya culture and the great personalities of Bharat. The instinct to connect and learn from life develops. For all the above material, Archan Vandan book has been made mandatory for every student. To enable the students to pronounce Saraswati Vandana, Ekatmta Mantra, Ekatmta Stotra, etc correctly, big Sanskrit words are divided into small parts and written in their copy, because of which the students can pronounce them correctly. Cont.

2) To promote musical instruments in schools:

This is a new experiment done in the last few years. Whereas earlier only musical instruments like harmonium, tabla, dholak, congo were included, today many modern and western musical instruments have also been included in the school such as: –

a) Tantra instruments: - violin, guitar, etc.

b) Wind instruments: - flute, melodica, mouth organ etc.

c) String Instruments: - Ghunghroo, Scraper, Happy Drum, Drum, Chimes, Xylophone, China Block, Cajon, Shaker, Maracas, Tambourine etc.

d) Avandha instruments: - Dhol, Tasha, Jambe, Duff, etc.

e) Electronic instruments: - Synthesizer, Tanpura etc.

The inclusion of the above instruments has increased the students' interest in music. Through this, they have got the opportunity to know and play Bharatiya musical instruments as well as Western musical instruments and their nature, structure, use, etc. Guitar is a western instrument, on which our students' played ragas like sitar and D.O.E. received high praise in the competition. That is, playing Bharatiya music on western instruments was a new experiment.

3) Competitions: - Participation in Prantiya and departmental competitions: For the last 7 years, competitions have been organized dVibhag-wise due to which 12 group and 12 individual awards were distributed in four departments. Except the dance competitions, all the western departmental and Prantiya competitions were organized in the Keshav Auditorium of the school, because all the musical instruments and sound system arrangements have been made well in this school. This is also a new experiment from benefit. which students get full The presentation of program is excellent.

The benefit of the above competitions was that the number of students participating in them increased significantly and students participated enthusiastically. This experiment increased the development of both the teacher and the students.

4) With the increase in the number of musical instruments, the level of Vandana has become

more beautiful and stronger.

5) Efforts have been made to connect students with new technology. There are some instruments which can be played by the app like Harmonium App, Guitar App, Tanpura App, Lehara Studio App, Taal App etc. Efforts have been made to connect students with such musical instruments. Also, providing an opportunity to learn singing, playing, and dancing by sharing videos based on music education made by Acharyas through YouTube channel and appropriate videos from other channels is also a new experiment., which many students take advantage of.

7) At the beginning of the session 2023, a video recording of an album "Prarthana Ke Swar" was sent to the society through YouTube by the Acharyas in which Acharyas from different subjects participated.

8) To give information to the students about Bharatiya musical instruments and to introduce them to their playing style, a 30minute program is organized from time to time in the Vandana session by specially invited artists, so that the students develop the inclination to learn those instruments.

9) Seven-day festival "Udaan" organized on Amrit Mahotsav of Independence in schools run by Vidya Bharati as well as schools run by government and non-government other organizations in Delhi was popular which every day, along with collective singing of patriotic songs, our students presented different singing styles and competitions were organized among the students at schools coming from outside. Classical music, subclassical music. folk songs, musical instruments. classical and folk-dance organized in competitions were the programme. The program started with Swagatam and the festival concluded with a dance drama "Bharativam" on the seventh day. The main attraction of which was to show a glimpse of the journey from the first voice raised for independence till the present in which about 800 students including teachers ensured their participation. Through this experiment, many students took new steps in the field of music with new thinking and technology.

10) As a result of the inspiration ...

of Principal Bela Mishra, Manager Rachna Dhanda and the efforts of the teachers, a musical dance drama of about 45 minutes based on Lord Ram was presented on Dussehra which was appreciated in Delhi. With the influence of this program, next year a complete Ramlila will be organized by the students in which about 900 students ensured their participation. The school keeps doing such experiments from time to time.

11) One benefit of doing such new experiments and inviting intelligent people of the society in the programs is that our students would be invited to the programs of other organizations and given presentations due to which there would no limit to the enthusiasm, hard work, dedication, and interest in music of the students.


