**Bring in discussion of Swa- in education:
Narendra Thakur**

Ujjain | A two-day joint Akhil Bharatiya meeting of Vidya Bharati Prachar Vibhag and Archives Department was held at Vidya Bharati Malwa Prant Office, Samrat Vikramaditya Bhawan, Ujjain.

On this occasion, Akhil Bharatiya Sah-Prachar Pramukh of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, Shri Narendra Thakur said that the Karyakartas of Vidya Bharati must develop their own discourse in education and if the opposition discourse is being established then they must change that through their actions.

Shri Thakur said that the discussion related to the contribution of Vidya Bharati in education and national idea should be taken to the society at large. Any discussion is built on continuity of content, so keep delivering your content regularly on different media platforms, he added. When a topic reaches across all mediums simultaneously and is being discussed, a narrative is formed. The Prachar Vibhag, therefore, must create a media ecosystem, he further said. The job of Prachar Vibhag is not to propagate any person or institution, but to propagate the national idea. Three central topics have been decided for discussion viz., Hindutva, Bharat, and Self (Swa-). Courses can be made a medium to bring in discussion of self in education. This may include subjects such as history, mathematics, and languages. From the point of view of your discussion, you can prepare an annual calendar at Akhil Bharatiya level in which special content can be prepared and broadcasted on important days of the year et cetra. At the provincial level, content can be developed on important days of the prant, prominent persons of the prant, important developments, and

Current issues. After content creation, regular contact and communication will have to be established with the media for its effective broadcast.

Shri Thakur said that Vidya Bharati has completed a long journey of imparting the ideas of Bharatiyata in education in the last 70 years. During this period the nature of media has also changed. We do not promote ourselves to gain fame but go to the society to further spread the idea of fraternity and national spirit. It is also important to document your work and this work can be done effectively by the Archives Department. It is the responsibility of the Prachar Vibhag of Vidya Bharati to inform every person of the society about the changes and research taking place in the education sector.



**Establishment of Bharatiya Education is the
goal of Vidya Bharati: Gobind Mahant**

At the same meet, Akhil Bharatiya Sangathan Mantri Shri Gobind Chandra Mahanta said that the aim of Vidya Bharati is to establish Bharatiya education. Bharatiyata and education based on Bharatiya cultural traditions is necessary in education. Vidya Bharati's teaching method has its own specialties. It is the job of the Prachar Vibhag to make society aware of these features.

Shri Mahant said that it is not possible to establish a school at every place in the country, but we can establish the ideal of a school in every locality and in every village. This would be ideal Bharatiya culture and tradition. Vidya Bharati's suggestions have been included in the NEP and National Curriculum Framework. It is necessary to establish a discussion to bring the National Education Policy into the system. It is very important to record the works of Vidya Bharati.

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Along with recording, an archive of records should also be created, so that material can be made available when necessary. Keeping in view the centenary year of the Sangh, special emphasis is expected on five major topics. These include social harmony, environment, sense of self, family empowerment and civic duty. Vidya Bharati being an education organization should create good content on these subjects and publish and disseminate it.



An effective action plan to be made by Prachar Vibhag Karyakarta: Sudhakar Reddy

Shri Sudhakar Reddy, Sangathan Mantri of Dakshin Kendriya Kshetra of Vidya Bharati and guardian of Prachar Vibhag presented a review of the topics discussed in the meeting and gave a message to the workers to work by holding effective meets. He presented an account of the past work of the Prachar Vibhag and gave information about the upcoming action plan. Vidya Bharati's Akhil Bharatiya Executive Member Dr. Lalit Bihari, Vidya Bharati Malwa Prant's Sangathan Mantri Shri Akhilesh Mishra and 87 workers from across the country were present at the meeting.

Selection of appropriate words and understanding the algorithm of social media key: Ravi Kumar

Shri Ravi Kumar, Sangathan Mantri of Vidya Bharati Jodhpur Prant and member of the central team of the Prachar Vibhag, emphasised the understanding the algorithm of social media and urged activists to post unique content. Along with this, follow the rule of right information, right time by selecting appropriate keywords and hashtags for social media. In such a situation, a Karyakarta should be assigned to handle the official social media account at Vidya Bharati Samvad Kendras. It would be better to have different people to handle different social media accounts.



Content for social media can be of many types, the main ones being text, photos, videos, shorts, reels etc. Contact social media influencers in their respective areas and provide them with content related to Vidya Bharati. At appropriate time, these social media influencers can use this material to create content for their platforms and thus the content of Vidya Bharati can reach the larger society. Prachar Vibhag Karyakarta should follow the authorized handles of education related departments so that they can keep getting updates from the world of education.

Creation of a social media Calendar

Shri Kumar further added that to successfully run official social media accounts, create a social media calendar. A calendar has been made by the Centre, but apart from this, social media calendar should also be made at the provincial level and preparations should be made in advance for posts on specific dates. Prepare content for social media in local languages too. Also create an archive of content shared on social media which can be used. This can be used if needed in future.

CONCEPTUAL ARTICLE**Acharya Vinoba's Vision for Teachers**

Acharya Vinoba Bhave was a sage-like personality. Not just thinking but creating work based on thinking, such was his prowess. Vinoba ji was originally from Maharashtra, but he spent most of his time in Gujarat. Due to Padyatra, he travelled all over Bharat. Due to his visit to Bharat, his dominance over many subjects, knowledge of every kind and the knowledge gained through that deep study was also the speciality of Vinoba ji's knowledge context. Vinoba ji had special love for Shrimad Bhagavad Gita as well as education. Vinoba ji's concepts in the context of education were very advanced and objective. Vinoba ji says, "Education does not create anything new, rather the work of education is to awaken what is present in the students. It is the duty of the teacher to discover the hidden perfection within the students and help in its development. This was his clear belief in the context of the teacher.

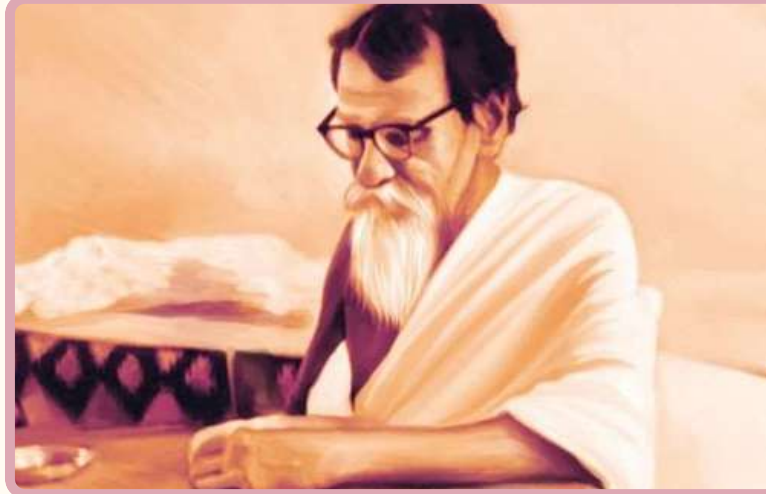
त्वं नो अस्या अमतेरूत क्षुधो अभिशस्तेरव स्पृधि।

Tvam Na Uti Tav Chitraya Dhiya Siksha Shachistha Gatuvit.

The meaning of the above Sanskrit verse is, "O great soul, O most powerful purifier of the path, You showed us the way to remove our ignorance, our hunger and our diseases. You give us good education, you reveal intelligence, protective power, productive power, and various types of powers." It would not be unfair to say that this verse in the Vedas has an important place in the context of education, more than that it is in the context of the teacher. In the Vedas, the teacher has been called 'Gatuvit' which means 'one who finds the path'. Gatuvit means path of travel and Vit means one who searches and brings out. This is a meaningful word found in the Vedas for teachers. Basically, in the Hindu culture that follows the Gurukul tradition, the place of Guru is extremely ordinary. The one who gives knowledge is our teacher, this is our ancient tradition. A teacher is the one who thinks about the welfare of the society based on the knowledge he has; hence the teacher has a unique importance in the society. We have our own ancient tradition of trusting the teacher. Being a teacher, the society looks towards the teacher with great trust. From ancient times to the present, the importance of a teacher in the society is extremely simple. Regarding this issue, there is a great need to understand Vinoba ji's vision as a teacher.



Once someone asked a question to Mahatma Gandhiji, What kind of work do you do? At that time Mahatma ji had said that "I do two such things as spinning and weaving thread". On this basis, Vinoba ji says, "If someone asked me a question, I would say that I am a teacher, I do the work of teaching." Vinoba ji explains this very accurately, "I did the Padyatra for 13 years. I continued to walk in it and if I did any work in this journey, it was that of a teacher and student." One who is a teacher is a student but one who is not a student is never a teacher. In such simple words he has expressed the superiority of a teacher. Vinoba ji says that not a single day has passed in my life when I have not studied something. This study was for new knowledge or for repetition of old knowledge. Vinoba ji had so much faith in the personality of his teacher.

Three Key Qualities of a Teacher : If it is necessary to think about a teacher who builds society through students, then it can be said that a teacher is a personality who is a combination of many qualities. Acharya Vinoba Bhave propounds the need for at least three qualities in the context of a teacher. These three qualities are of the following form –

- 1) Teachers should have love for students. Only those whose life is filled with affection and love based on these two components can be teachers. The affection and love that a mother has, Vinoba ji says that the teacher should also have it.
- 2) A teacher should always be studious. The world is constantly changing. What kind of knowledge do students need in this changing era? The basic role of the teacher should be to update that knowledge by giving it to the students. For this, Vinoba ji suggests that the teachers themselves should remain constantly studious.

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3) The teacher should stay away from politics. In politics there are such feelings as justice-injustice, own-alien. Only the education sector is different from this. In the field of education, everyone is their own and this is the lesson that must be imparted to the students. Due to which Vinoba ji says that teachers should stay away from partisan politics.

Acharya Vinoba has told the sequence of education – ‘Matriman’, ‘Pitriman’, ‘Acharyaman’ means education should be given first from the mother, later from the father and finally from the Acharya. Children receive childhood education from their mother. Good values can be imparted in childhood only by the mother. It cannot be said whether anyone else can do this much or not. That is why Vinoba ji emphasizes on women's education. Women teach children and children make the future of the country, hence the need for women's education is very high. Explaining this, Vinoba ji says that the responsibility of primary education should be given in the hands of women, this will lead to better development. A woman knows very well how to behave with a child; hence Vinoba ji has put forward a simple but important idea that education should be 'mother-oriented'. In Mahabharata, Lord Shri Krishna had asked for such a boon as ‘Matrihasten Bhojanam’. Related to the same, Vinoba ji has presented such an idea in the context of education as ‘Matrimukhen Shikshanam’. This reflects Vinoba ji's awareness regarding the education of small children.

Responsibilities of Teachers

Patanjali has some guiding Yoga Sutras for teachers. That is, Patanjali has used the word Acharya for teachers. In this context, he has expressed thoughts about God. Patanjali says that God is the teacher of his ancestors. It has been said in our ancient literature, “Tvamev is mother, and father is Tvamev, Tvamev is Bandhuscha Sakha Tvamev”.

But here God is the Guru and what are the characteristics of a Guru, he gives freedom to the disciples. Makes them inclined to learn from experience. ‘Learning from experience’ is what Vinoba ji meant. Both teacher and student learn from each other's behaviour That is, what is not given is education. What is not taken, which can be accounted for, or something can be recorded cannot be education. The real calculation of the caloric value is visible not on paper but on the body itself.

Vinoba ji says that the experience gained, consumed, and digested is education. According to Vinoba ji, education cannot be counted. Life is teaching; hence Vinoba ji urges that teachers should impart education only in the field of life. That's why Vinoba ji gives the example of Kurukshetra. Lord Shri Krishna narrated the Bhagavad Gita to Arjuna in Kurukshetra. Even in solitude, Shri Krishna could have told this divine knowledge to Arjuna. But instead of doing so, to give the education of life in the field of life itself and realize the knowledge gained through the education given Therefore, the field of direct life has been chosen by Lord Krishna. It is this type of life education that Vinoba ji finds important.

In the context of today's teacher personality, the word 'Acharya' is popular. In this word Acharya, ‘char’ is the root and aa is the prefix. That is, the meaning of the word Acharya is in the context of conduct. Acharya means in the words of Vinoba ji “the one who conducts is Acharya”. Vinoba ji says that the person who has direct knowledge of putting into practice whatever is to be taught and getting others to do it, should be called 'Acharya'. Through such hard-working teachers, hard-working students will be formed and as a result, a hard-working nation will be created which is a necessity of social life.

According to Acharya Vinoba ji, the mantra of your education should be Sachchidananda. Without this Karmayoga, life cannot progress. Chitta is the yoga of knowledge without which life cannot be made and there is no interest in life except happiness. The education which has the combination of truth, consciousness and happiness is the true education. Through this medium, we all hope that a hard-working generation that gives true education will be created through teachers.

NEP game changer for start ups: Governor

Kurukshetra | In the 'Shiksha Kumbh' organized under the joint aegis of Vidya Bharati Haryana and National Institute of Technology (NIT) Kurukshetra, Governor Bandar Dattatreya said that the National Education Policy-2020 is a historic reform in the Bharatiya education system. 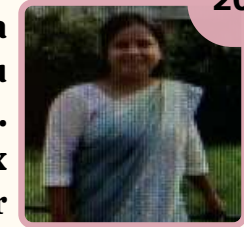
