

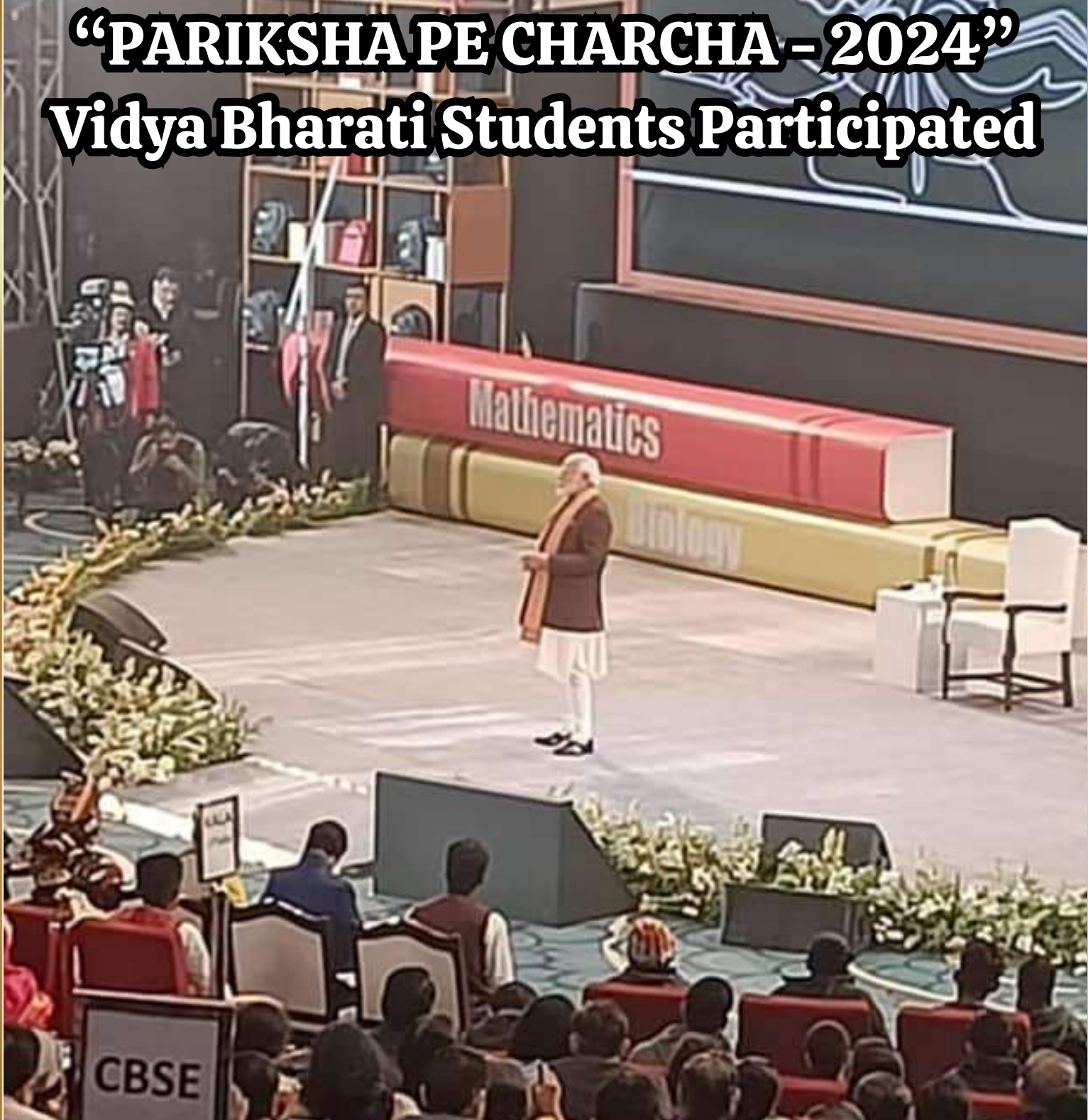

Education and Social Awareness



Basic Approaches to Education

Generally there are two sides/approaches to education. The first is that education is a process of talent development, It is the process of manifestation and promotion of inherent qualities. In this way the inherent talent of the child, effort or process for nature and tendency is the first and foremost objective of education.

The other side of education is, Its environmental or environmental suitability. Education should be such that it helps the child or person to adapt to his/her environment. And Through the lessons learned, a person's commitment towards the environment should be increased to adapt to the social needs of his environment. Here environment or environment is used in its broadest sense. Village, city, society, country and even the entire global situation comes under its ambit. Only proper compatibility with the environment gives meaning to education. Due to which social awareness comes and the society is able to carry education from one generation to the next. In this way, the first aspect determines the task of personal education i.e. the development and promotion of a particular person's thoughts, guidelines, content and social dimensions along with the development of his internal capabilities. On the other hand, the other side emphasizes on maintaining continuity of social values/qualities as per social needs. In this way, if the first aspect is personal then the second aspect is of social consciousness. Here a third aspect of education can also be conceptualized, Which talks about balance and harmony between these two sides. Education should be such that it adapts to the needs and changes of the society from time to time. And by monitoring and assessing the knowledge related to various related fields, an adjustment should be made between personal inherent and acquired knowledge.

There are endless possibilities for the development of inherent talent, But it should be in accordance with the use of environmental utilities. Only then will education be called proper. If a person acquires the power of spontaneous earth destruction And If one gets pleasure from that then it cannot be called proper education. True education will not accept this and will be acceptable only according to environmental commitment.

Compatibility with the Environment

If social knowledge is called Ganga and personal knowledge is called Yamuna, then the relatively moderate stream flowing after the confluence of both is actually Saraswati i.e. Shiksha / Gyan / Vidya.

Education or Saraswati is the continuous flow of knowledge which organizes the continuous flow of contemporary individual knowledge in keeping with the time, environment and various social underlying social conditions. Flowing knowledge is the true education, that is, the acquisition of changing knowledge around eternal social values according to time and situation makes education strong. In its context, it means environmental compatibility.

- Development of necessary science and technology while remaining compatible with the entire world.
- To be compatible with the earth/environment, there should be concern for the flora and fauna.
- To be compatible with the society, there needs to be a resolve to fight social evils like dowry, exploitation, drug addiction and corruption.
- It is the responsibility of education to be able to make its environment - village, city and neighbourhood - essentially clean and orderly.
- Education will have to be productivity enhancing and employment oriented. If this happens, social values will automatically be protected.

Another very important aspect is that there should be proper communication and sensitive communication.





For this, initial knowledge in one's own language and knowledge of other languages is also necessary for effective business. This is also absolutely necessary for the unity, harmony and sovereignty of the country. Therefore, there should be proper arrangements for teaching and learning of bilingual and trilingual languages at the appropriate level.

To make the presented article more objective, effective and concise, we would like to say that education should be compiled for social service and social reform. When the school students protest against the bad bricks, adulterated cement etc. being used in the construction of roads and buildings, the contractor should make improvements to it, by holding a 15-15 minute dharna by the girl students before and after school around the main hole of the road. Recovering, taking out rallies from time to time to prevent addiction and drugs, visiting villages and localities to urge people to drink clean water and distributing bleaching powder and red medicine (potassium permanganate), participating in literacy campaigns. These are examples which show how useful our students can be for social service, this will inculcate in them the spirit of spontaneous service, strength of character and

and sense of responsibility.

Therefore, along with education, such courses or extra-curricular activities should be added formally and informally.

Teachers will also have to be ready and prepared to provide this type of inspiring education to children. Not only this, the older generation will also have to leave the stereotypes and be ready to change with time.

Every effort should be made to make boys and girls aware of their health and develop proud feelings for their home, family, village, city, state and country. For this, appropriate programmes, activities and conferences, seminars and dramas etc. on the problems of the country and society should be included in education. They should be motivated to do social work by organizing programs like cleanliness, self-help work, agricultural work, village darshan etc.

It would be beneficial for all the boys and girls to have mandatory teaching of social responsibility works and programs like tree planting, military exercise, self-defense, social service, labor donation, scouting and yoga as per their interest, so that the objective of social concern and social awareness can be fulfilled.

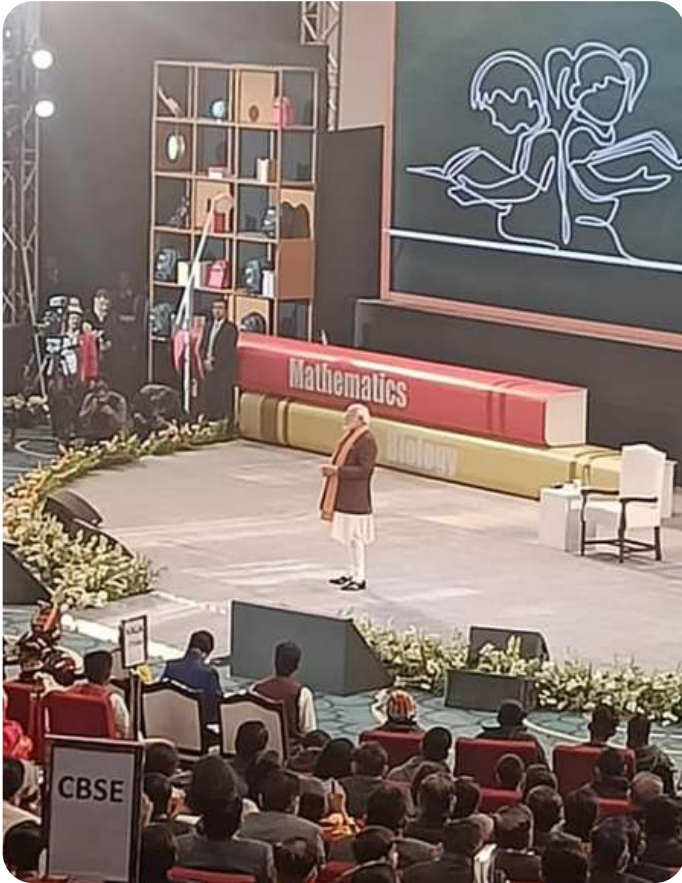

Akhil Bharatiya Parishad Bhaithak of Shishu Vatika, Haridwar



Haridwar | The annual Shishu Vatika Akhil Bharatiya Parishad meeting and training was organized from 17-21 February 2024 at Saraswati Shishu Mandir, Ranipur, Haridwar. Akhil Bharatiya Sangathan Mantri Shri Gobind Chandra Mahanta, Convener Asha Dhanki ji and Co-conveners (Shri Hukumchand Muvanta and Smt. Namrata Dutt) and Kshetriya coordinators and Co-conveners were expected in this event. Out of the expected 25 participants, 24 participants were present. Apart from these, 3 out of 4 specially invited members were present. The total number was 27.

The proceedings of the meeting were read by Shri Hukumchand Muvanta. While presenting the introduction of the council meeting and training, Ms. Asha Thanki said that every year this council sits for 5 days. In this journey from 2004-05 to 2024, the generation has changed but the values and traditions remain constant. For this stability, work has been done in the four Kshetriyas of teaching, training, research and publication in Shishu Vatika. Shishu Vatika across the country from Akhil Bharatiya Training Centre, Gandhidham Gujarat That is, an environment of Bharatiya teaching system of child education/informal education is being created. Our ideology in early childhood education has been accepted in the NEP 2020. Therefore, now we are not only teachers/instructors of our school. Rather, we have to emerge as national teachers/trainers.

There was presentation, comparative thinking and discussion of Kshetriya topics from different perspectives. In the training 2 important theoretical topics were highlighted by Shri Divyanyu G Dave, former regulator of Children University Gujarat-1. Bharatiya philosophy of life, and 2. Panchapadi teaching method. Bharat's philosophy of life is spiritual. That is why education in Bharat means liberation. The geographical structure of Bharat itself is a factor of spirituality, That is why it is called Dev Bhoomi. Therefore, to understand the spirituality of Bharatiya life, one has to understand its geographical structure

and understand the integrity, continuity and cyclicity of life. Bharat was called Vishwa Guru because of its specialty in the Panchapadi teaching method. Along with westernization, Herbert's teaching method came into practice in teacher training. It focuses on the content of the teaching methodology. Hence it is not so effective. The center point of education is the student.

Therefore, the teaching method should also be student centric (five-worded). The principles of Panchapadi teaching method are student centered which is related to the basic elements of education (pedagogy, psychology and nervous system). Detailed guidance was received on all these subjects in 2 periods respectively.

To listen to this deep topic of Panchapadi, Education Minister of Uttarakhand, Dr. Dhan Singh Rawat and primary/secondary education officers were also present throughout both the periods. Shri Dhan Singh appreciated the cooperation and guidance of Vidya Bharati in the context of NEP 2020 in Uttarakhand Education Department. Information about the status of use of mother tongue in nursery schools in the country was discussed by Shri Gobind Mahanta. To make Bharatiyata the basis, Ms. Asha Didi determined the points on the basis of discussion on the internal and external form of the nursery. Shri Bhuvanta and Smt. Namrata discussed Acharya training and parent training respectively. Direct viewing and review of the activities of the garden, suggestions were taken on Shishu Vatika curriculum and Anand boo Kumar Time sheet and diary preparation (taught by Chalisa Ben, Dakshin Madhya Kshetra). Shri Bharatbhai Dokai (Margdarshak Samarth Bharat Prakalya) gave guidance on the topic of Foundational Stage (5+).

After the guidance of Shri Gobind Mahanta and blessings of respected Vedanand Mrigu Ashram, the meeting ended with the singing of Vande Mataram. The school family as well as Prant Sangathan Mantri Shri Bhuvan Chander, Shri Vijay and Shri Vinod had special contribution in the commendable arrangements of the meeting.



Training to become Army Officers and Athletes in Jodhpur, preparation for NDA from 9th Class

Admission will be done through Examination and Interview, Facilities will be prepared with Rs 101 crore And 4 Blocks of G Plus 3, 1 Block of G Plus 2 and 6 Blocks of G Plus 1 will be made.



Jodhpur | Vidya Sankul is busy in preparing the institute outline for entry into Lal Sagar. Students wishing to take admission here will have to go through examination and interview, etc. Tuition charges will also be kept normal, so that students from across the country can study here. Here four blocks of G Plus 3 (ground floor to three floors), one of G Plus 2 and 6 blocks of G Plus 1 will be developed. Along with this, Bharat Mata temple, pathway and parking, etc. will also be built.

An institute is being created to inspire cultured and patriotic youth to join the country's army. Preparation for competitive exams like NDA will also be done here. Nirmal Gehlot, president of Vidya Sankul Project Lal Sagar, said that children of Paschim Rajasthan are less able to become officers in the army. This project will produce good officers as well as Athletes.

Vidya Sankul Project Lal Sagar Sachiv Shambhu Singh Charan said that additional Classes for talented children will be run in the hostel. Here expert teachers will make children prepare for NDA. Vidya Sankul Project member Shri Devendra said that the project will be completed in 10 months and construction is being done on more than 10 bighas of land. Retired army officers will be appointed who can prepare for NDA.

Research Centre - A modern center will be built for research work, which will provide research guidance to the youth.

Sports Centre - International level sports grounds will be built in the institute for athletics, wrestling, judo, kabaddi, kho-kho, swimming etc. where international level Athletes will be prepared.

Aradhana Kendra - It will be an art center showcasing Bharat and Bharat's scientific achievements. It will be prepared to attract domestic and foreign tourists.

Talent Development Centre - Special talents of administrative, technology and information technology will be prepared. Along with this, an art development center will be built for music, dance, painting, sculpture, and architecture.

Skill Development Centre - Not only bookish knowledge, but manual skills will also be taught here so that the trainees can contribute to economic development in future.

Technical education will be provided to the local youth through Vocational Education Centre- ITI, Polytechnic College.

Acharya Training Centre - A training center will be prepared to train the Acharyas of Vidya Bharati. A hostel equipped with time and facilities will be built for the children studying here.
