- We are fortunate to have inherited a tradition of unity that startles the minds of the outsiders but also attracts them. What is the secret behind such unity? Needless to say, it is our all-inclusive culture. It is our conduct and way of life that transcends the differences between worship, tradition, language, region, caste, etc., and extends our affinity from our own family to the entire world family. Our forefathers realized the truth of the unity of existence. Thus, they became aware of the principle of Dharm, which fuels the progress of the Body, Mind, and Intellect, and leads to Moksha by balancing both Arth (Means) and Kaam (Ends). Based on that realization, they evolved a culture that implemented the four eternal values of Dharmatattva (truth, compassion, purity, and penance). Prosperous and secure from all sides, this was possible only because of the bountifulness of our motherland. This was possible only because of the food, water, and air of our motherland which is secure and prosperous from all sides.
