Shivpuri Manthan on Village Development: Sanyojak Mandal Sammelan

For the first time after independence, 2500 village rishis of 423 villages did collective contemplation on Village Development.

Bhopal | Literacy, Harmony, Swadeshi, Culture, Tradition, Self-reliance, Security and Environment, etc are the 9 dimensions of Village Development on which different sessions were taken, when the author tried to probe them, everyone expressed their views openly. Most of the participating members said that the role of the Convenor Board in the implementation of the National Education Policy was explained very clearly in the conference. The discussion session on the topic Ideal Hindu Family was very useful.

For the first time after independence, 2500 village rishis from 423 villages sat and discussed collectively the subject of village development. These people involved in the conference were not great academicians but, they had just come to share the mantras which they had got from tradition and discovered by reading scriptures, how the world can be healthy and happy. Everyone had some common concerns in this discussion. Many people told that earlier people used to think for the betterment of the village while sitting near the bonfire of the chaupal, sparrows used to chirp on the eaves of the house, and there used to be a competition to cross the puddle by swimming. The masters of the akhara used to force the village itself. Gurukuls were not only centers of education, but also schools for community cooperative life. The cow was worshiped in every house. There were joint families and one earner used to feed everyone. With the scattered flowers of Tesu, it seemed as if the earth had covered Pitambari. In the marriage of the daughter of the village, the whole village used to wash its feet and cooperated with body, mind, and wealth. All festivals were celebrated together in the village, in the fog of Holi the whole village used to jump in fun. Such a unique example of social harmony is not seen anywhere. Panchayats used to sit and major decisions were taken by Panch Parmeshwar. The description of such ideal villages is found in our scriptures -

Grame-Grame Sabha Karya, Grame-Grame Katha Shubha | Pathshala Malishala, Pratiparva Mahotsvaa ||

Then there was Ramrajya not only in Ayodhya but in the whole country. The doors of the house were never closed. Every woman was a form of mother, sister, and daughter. Touching someone else's money was considered a sin. The ant used to get grains and the elephant used to get its fill.

No one was helpless or sick in the village. Our villages



were a live example of what village self-rule is in the true sense. No one could buy the faith of Gamai soldiers even in the period of almost one thousand years of subjugation. When Nawabs with big turrets and big influencers did not get tired of singing vilifications against the British, even then these Gavru's had put their lives at stake to save every inch of the country's land for their religion and culture, but today the rural life in such a form-of is not visible.

Gandhi always used to say that Bharat lives in villages. The Hind Swarajya that Gandhi used to talk about was actually Gramraj. Today hoteling and bottling are becoming a pastime. Gentlemen seem helpless in front of the heights of corrupt, misguided dishonest people. but still, there is a solution left. For the dream of the ultimate glory of the nation to come true, we have to return to the villages. These dense cities of cement, and concrete are not in a position to bear much pressure of population. Villages have to be made a model of entrepreneurship, harmony and self-reliance. If we move forward with the mantra 'Sabke Saath Sabka Saath' by inculcating the spirit of Swadeshi, then no one can stop Bharat from becoming a golden bird soon. Today the crisis of breathing is getting deeper in front of us. It is the responsibility of all of us to keep the environment of 50 meters around us clean and safe. Measures have to be taken to save every drop of water. Without demolishing the strong walls of small-big, forward-backward, and high-low, social harmony will remain only a matter of promises and claims. By saving herbs and ensuring their use, a healthy Bharat will be born.





Villages have to be made capable and self-reliant

After the Shivpuri Manthan, a discussion has spread everywhere that the path of 'Jag Sirmaur Banayein Bharat' will emerge from the footpaths of the village. A self-respecting nation will be able to stand up only by making the villages capable, and self-reliant and this will not happen by copying the West, but by Bharatiya knowledge tradition and combining modernity. This work is not going to be completed by any one person, but lakhs of people will have to come forward to start this National Ritual.

Coming out of the ego, we all have to be ourselves and great. Many contemplation camps like Shivpuri will have to be organized in this Amritkal.

How much Shankar is able to digest the Halahal that comes out of this Manthan, to that extent a happy, prosperous world and a glorious Bharat will be able to take shape. Educational Enlightenment of Param Pujya Shri Guruji

Second Sarsanghchalak of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh Param Pujya Madhavrao Sadashivrao Golwalkar Upakhya Shri Guruji used to think holistically on all aspects of social life in the light of the basic concepts of Hinduism. While being a Professor of Zoology at Banaras Hindu University, he acquired some ideas from his own experience in the field of education. From time to time, his clear thoughts regarding education have appeared in his speeches. Some of the main points are presented here.

Purpose of School Operation

Shri Guruji had come on the occasion of the silver jubilee celebration of Shrimad Bhagwad Gita Senior Secondary School, Kurukshetra, and Bhoomi Pujan (29 January 1973) of Geeta Niketan Aawasiya Vidyalaya, Kurukshetra. Some excerpts from his address at that time -

"Many years ago, I was present at the foundation stone laying ceremony of the building of this school. An objective of starting the school was put forward. In the prevalent education system, there is no effective system for imparting the values of religion, ethics, patriotism, exclusive devotion toward the motherland, etc. Efforts will be made to remove this deficiency in this school.

The British systematically tried to make the national society of this country forget its history, culture, and civilization. This type of selfless education continued in the country. At that time, knowledgeable people recognized this diplomacy and that is why there was opposition to English education during the freedom movement. Some experiments on national education were also done. But the fervor of possessiveness and self-respect that was there during the period of subjugation got vanished as soon as the foreign rule went away. Forgetting our pride and blindly imitating foreigners, we forgot our fundamental principles. If you look in any direction in living, tolerance, character, sense of duty, ideological role, etc., you will find that there is only blind imitation without conscience. That is why we are unable to understand the real meaning of education.

The real meaning of education is to orient a man towards the ultimate goal of his life.

In fact, education is that through which man can achieve the best goal in life by progressing progressively. Shri Krishna himself mentions this goal in the last chapter of Gita -

Manmana Bhava Madbhakto Madya Maa Namaskuru | Maam-Evaishvasi Satvam Te Pratiiane Privo'si Me ll



'Manmana' means take me in your inner self. 'Madbhakto' means that you should not remain 'separated' from me. 'Madya' means living a life of sacrifice for me and 'Maa Namaskuru' means he surrenders to me with salutations. Here it is not the person named Shri Krishna but the basic power of creation, origin and annihilation is in the form of Supreme God, for whom it was said - Manmana Bhava

To achieve this ultimate goal, many virtues are necessary in a human being, which have to be cultivated from childhood. To live truthfully, to have no enmity or hatred towards anyone, to remain pure in body, mind and spirit, to have self-control and to expand my inner self in such a way that the whole world is my family and I am in the service of this society. Surrender to but don't let any selfishness enter your mind.

Characteristic Of The BharatiyaWay Of Life

This fact is inherent in considering the whole world as one's family. The vision of Bharativalife is that the society living in each region should live according to its specialty. All nations should live with friendship, love and fraternity while inventing the specialty of their traditional way of life and promoting those specialties. If this vision is not there, friendship becomes extinct due to petty selfishness, then there will be constant struggle. No nation will allow others to remain free for its selfishness.

Keeping our national characteristics safe is the work of human welfare, but it is not easy. In the present conflict situation of the world, this difficult task can only be done by those who know the traditions of the nation, have proper respect for their forefathers and have unshakable devotion towards the motherland of the nation and hold this sentiment in their conscience. That not to consider personal interest in front of national interest. The nation is protected and enriched only by the united power of such persons, who make their lives completely sacred for the worship of the nation's deity. To fulfill this objective, it is necessary to



prepare people of patriotism and character, for which the rituals of childhood are most important.

In summary, Shri Guruji says, these words have to be inculcated in the mind of every student that I will serve my nation; I will strengthen the various streams of knowledge-science in the nation; I will make a deep study of all the paths of progress that are visible in the modern world; I will not think even an iota of my selfishness. School is needed only to create such determined intelligence in the conscience of every student.

Focal Point Of Education: Teacher

The fundamental concept of education in Bharat is that education is the manifestation of the inherent powers of a human being and not just the stuffing of some information into the student's mind. We believe that the realization and expression of the Supreme Consciousness that exists within us is the basic objective of the education system. The guidelines are given by our Rishi-Manishis-saints and ascetics regarding the process of achieving this objective, the teacher has a major role in implementing them in the life of the child. The first task of the teacher is to inculcate the ten principles of Yama and Niyama in the minds of the students. Most of the youth do not know that we have an ancient history rich in excellent knowledge of various aspects of life because their teachers and parents did not tell them about it in their student life. Today's education system lacks the desire and effort to learn. Bidding farewell to the books of standard authors, guides and keys has become prevalent. Tuition has been accepted as the easy way to success. In fact, good teachers should consider it as an insult to their ability and conscientiousness. The side effect of these shortcuts is that the ability to understand, the nature of the initiative, and the willpower of the students are decreasing. On failure of 'short routes', the student then tends to get success through 'immoral routes' as well.

Talks of humanity or globalism are meaningless without a solid basis of nationality. Our national philosophy has always embraced the welfare of all mankind. Only the bright form of our nationalism will lead our children towards the highest values of human welfare.

Teacher-Student Relationship

Students are not a separate class from the rest of society. Only the merits and demerits of society come into them. As a result of their immature stage, lack of experience, and predominance of adult emotions, their activities appear in the form of uncontrollable

excitement. No rituals of good behavior are done on them. Neither do they have any such lofty goal for which they can devote their energy, nor do they often see any inspirational philosophy in social life. In order to guide them properly, there is a need for special qualification in the teachers too – they should have excellent knowledge of the subject, their character should be impeccable, love and intimate behavior towards the students should be their innate nature.

Role Of Family And Society

The entire responsibility of giving the right direction to the children is not only on the teachers. The smallest unit of society in our country is the family. Children learn by imitation. The environment they get in the family will become of that nature. Where has the mother gone as the 'first guru' at her place? Virtues such as conscientiousness, keeping one's promise, respect for labor, readiness to cooperate with society, and devotion towards the motherland, etc. can be taught from early life itself.

The spirit of service and the nature of living a collective life should be developed in the students of adolescent age. For this, it is necessary to give proper direction to their organized power. Student organizations should be kept free from political parties.

Audio-visual means of entertainment and newspapers and magazines also play a big role in building the lives of the students. These mediums should also follow their responsibility for the kind of content they serve. Display anything in the name of modernity and fashion, it should not be discounted.

How to get an education abroad?

A friend from Gujarat went to the University of Illinois in the US to study engineering, from where he wrote a letter to Shri Guruji. In his reply, Shri Guruji wrote - "You return home efficiently after getting more eligibility. It would be good to study the social life there, the best qualities of the people, personal and social character, national traditions and ethics. etc. It will be beneficial to learn about the efforts of the progress of industry and agriculture, and the attitudes of educational institutions and their teachers and students in a better way. No society is completely innocent, so the attention goes toward the faults. But it is beneficial to see better with effort. This is the way of self-promotion. By studying in this way, you will get the knowledge to create a modern life on the basis of the traditions of the self-society in the country and you will prove to be very helpful to the nation.

Ekal Vidyalaya Initiative, Polythene Free Village

Rajasthan | Acharya Rav Kumar of Ekal Vidyalaya, 78 GB village, Anupgarh tehsil of Sriganganagar district, thought that polythene bags and wrappers are scattered in the village, eating which cows are dying and the land is also getting contaminated. On this, Students and teachers of Ekal Vidyalaya together resolved to make the village polythene free. Students were asked to bring plastic wrappers and bags to school every day from the streets of the village. Every day who brought how many wrappers and bags, started counting and putting them in a pit. The Students who brought more polythene were encouraged by clapping. This sequence continued and gradually plastic bags and wrappers stopped appearing in the streets of the village.

When polythene bags were not found in the streets, they started bringing plastic from the bushes. Later, in order to prevent polythene from being used in homes, a large meeting of parents was held and a resolution was taken to make the village polythene-free by making them aware of the harm caused by polythene. Cloth bags made by the institute were distributed to all the houses in the village and the people were urged to bring goods from the market in these bags.

Students also took out an awareness rally with placards in hand to give the message of freedom from polythene. Due to the efforts of the school, eco-bricks were started from polythene. With this successful effort, has been taken in many other villages to get rid of polythene.


former student Kaushlesh Kumar Singh.
