350th year of the Accession of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj

On the occasion of the 350th year of the accession of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, Hon. Sarkaryavah Shri Dattatreya Hosabale gave his statement



Panipat (Haryana) | Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj is one of those great personalities of Bharat who unshackled the society from the slave mentality and instilled a sense of self-confidence and self-respect in it. He was coronated and Hindavi Swaraj was formed on Jyeshtha Shuddha Trayodashi. This year marks the commencement of the 350th year of the establishment of 'Hindavi Swaraj'. On the eve of this, several programs will be organized throughout the country including Maharashtra. On this auspicious occasion, the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) solemnly reminisces Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and appeals to the Swayamsevaks and all the sections of the society to commemorate the epoch-making moment of the establishment of Hindavi Swaraj by participating in all such events.

The life of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj is full of unparalleled bravery, masterly strategy, thorough expertise

in warfare, sensitive, fair and impartial administration, respect for women, staunch Hindutva and many such characteristics. Many incidents testifying the traits such as faith and confidence in his mission and God during adverse times, respect for parents and teachers, standing shoulder to shoulder with the compatriots in their moments of joy and despair and taking along all sections of the society, can be found in his life. 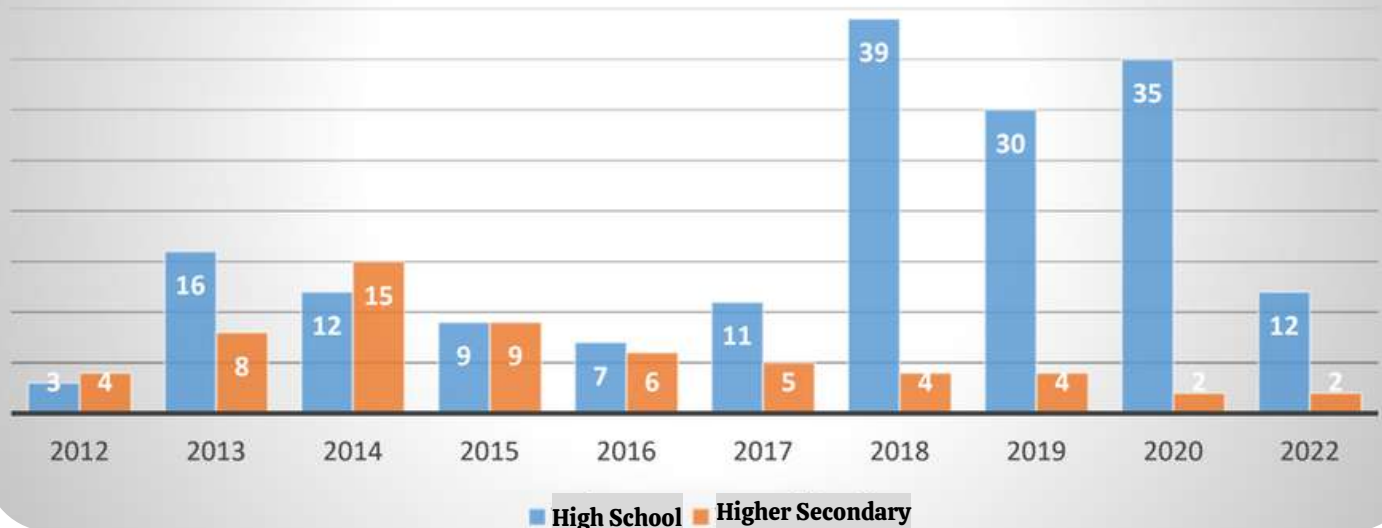
The specifics that have emerged from the study behind

getting a place in the highest merit list is the following: -

1. Regular attendance of the student in the school.
2. Determination to score 100% marks.
3. Teaching work done whole-heartedly by subject teachers
4. Repetition of the subject material taught.
5. Preparation of Notes.
6. Doing self-study to increase memory power.
7. Keeping distance from TV, Mobile, and Computer.
8. To study according to the planned timetable.
9. Continuous contact and cooperation of Acharya.
10. Medha month- January and February are celebrated as Medha month. Special Varges start at the school level. Counseling is done for students and parents.
11. A five-day workshop is organized for meritorious students at the district level. In this, the subject expert teaches the students. 5 students are selected from each school to join this Varg.
12. Based on the blueprint of the board, practice is done by making model question papers.
13. Night Varges is conducted. Acharya, the guardian, and everyone participates.
14. Experiments as above go on throughout the year.

In this way, Vidya Bharati is making the name of Saraswati Shishu Mandir proud by reaching at high positions not only in the merit list of the Board of Secondary Education but also in the field of service, the administrative field, and in the political field.

Organization of comprehensive Health Camp

Medical teams assisted in conducting Health Camps as well as in Disease Screening, Treatment, and Medicine distribution.

Dr. Prabhat Moktan, Dentist - Dr. Chopel Doma Bhutia, Dr. Dimple Singh, Nurse Hari Maya Nepal, Nurse Krishna Subba, along with the other doctors from Regional Institute of Ayurveda, Gangtok, Sariga.
